Robert Fasol is organist/choirmaster of St. Luke's United Methodist Church in Oklahoma City, where he has served since 1989. There he plays a 95 rank, four manual Aeolian – Skinner pipe organ built in 1957. A recipient of both a bachelor's and master's degree in Organ Performance from TCU, Robert studied with Emmet G. Smith, and pursued post-graduate studies at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary with Dr. Al Travis.

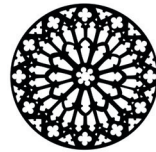
Good Friday

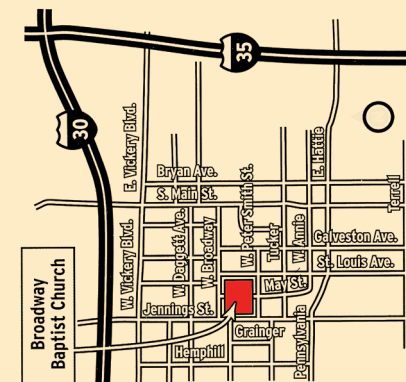
