The Cliburn organ was handcrafted by Casavant Frères Limités, St. Hyacinthe, Quebec, Canada. The organ is the largest organ of French aesthetics in the world, reflecting the basic concept of the 18th and 19th century French organ builders. Exceptional in size and design, the Cliburn Organ has 10,615 pipes, 191 ranks, 129 independent stops, spread across 11 divisions controlled by dual 5-manual consoles. Two unique features of the organ are the horizontal trumpets in the front and back of the sanctuary and the addition of a Bombarde division specially designed to play with orchestral forces. The Cliburn Organ's pipes, two consoles, and oak cases were crafted to fit the grand proportions of the sanctuary's modified Gothic architecture.
